The Coats Farmer's Day Committee extends a cordial invitation to exhibitors, crafts persons and food vendors to join us for our 96th Annual Farmer's Day Celebration. **Last year the Military estimated our attendance at 16,000.** At this event booths will be available to you for showing and selling your creative wares and food items. Please remember that this is a FAMILY oriented event and the Festival committee reserves the right to refuse your application if it is deemed inappropriate.

Event Times:.....Saturday, October 9, 2010 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm
Place.....Main Street, Coats, North Carolina

Fees and Registration.....To guarantee a selling space, the **entry fee** and attached **Vendor Application** must be completed and returned to the Coats Chamber office by **September 24, 2010.** \$20.00 of the Entry fee becomes non-refundable after August 30, 2010.

Please return your entry fee and vendor application as soon as possible as we have a limited number of spaces to rent. Electricity will be available to those who need it.

General Information.....All exhibits will be outdoors on a paved street. Exhibitors should provide their own tables, chairs, change, display materials and rain or sun protection. You must provide your own tent or awning. The vendor spaces will be 12 ft. deep and 12 ft. wide (wide is along street curbing.) **If your tent or awning is larger and encroaches into an adjoining space, you will be required to rent two spaces.** You may not drive tent stakes into the cement or asphalt. You must leave your area clean and orderly.

Booth Size &

Assignment.....Booth space will be assigned on a **first-come, first-serve** basis, upon the receipt of a completed vendor application and entry fee. You may request a certain space, but we cannot guarantee any placements until all entries are in. We do reserve the right to change your site due to some unforeseen complication. The spaces will be marked off in a clear manner and plainly numbered. You must stay in your designated space so we do not have to ask you to move after you are set up.
